POWER DISTRIBUTION IN THE WORLD ECONOMY: NEW CHALLENGES

OBJECTIVE:

The main objective of the meeting is to provide a platform for productive exchanges between scholars on the new challenges of the world economy. Inequality within economies and in the global market is affected by the distribution of power between different groups in the national and global economies and the countries of the world. Changes in the distribution of power have arguably had a major impact on the economic performance worldwide in recent years. This conference will focus on how to analytically conceptualize power in the global context, explain the causes and consequences of shifts in the distribution of power, and explore what this implies for economic analysis and economic policy. The colloquium will be organized by the Instituto Superior de Economia e Gestão (ISEG) in Lisbon, Portugal, in collaboration with the University of Brasilia (UnB), Brazil.
